Our Approach

Selby Reserve sits within a low-density community on the outskirts of Bacchus Marsh, overlooking the Moorabool River valley.

Our role was to develop a previously-designed Master Plan undertaken by other consultants, within a budget of \$300K.

For this project PM&A included Landscape Architect Scott Munro in the project team as a subconsultant. We also included a site survey within our scope, including Peter Mirams of Step Surveying in our team.

Through analysis we identified that a water body onsite had ecological values and was potentially habitat for the endangered Growling Grass Frog. On our site walk we also identified a potential Wurungeri Woi Wurrung scar tree.

Our documentation set included existing conditions, planting, and setout plans, revegetation schedules and specifications.

The project is scheduled for completion in 2023-24.
